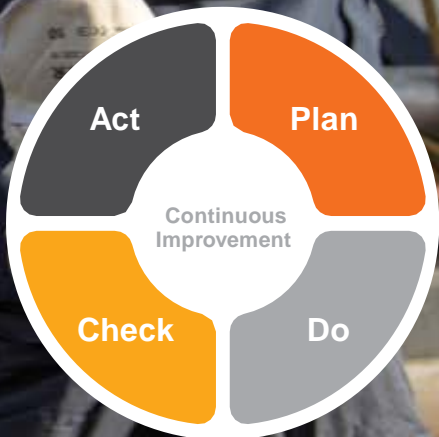
It's important to note that how easily a virus spreads person-to-person can vary.
